Greetings park supporters,

It has been one week since the launch of the Briones Pilot Project, and Park District staff and volunteers have been out at Briones observing and speaking to visitors about the Pilot Project – *pictured below are some of the volunteers at a recent tabling event*. We really appreciate the public's support and understanding as we implement the pilot project.

As a reminder, there are weekend restrictions in the Pilot Zone ([map](#)) depending on whether it's an ODD weekend date (bikes and hikers *okay*) or an EVEN weekend date (horses and hikers *okay*). This weekend, for example, mountain bikers & hikers will be allowed in the zone on Saturday, April 29 and equestrians & hikers will be allowed on Sunday, April 30. There is a way to bypass the zone from Alhambra Staging Area by taking Orchard Trail west to Toyon Canyon Trail (these two trails are outside the pilot zone).

How You Can Help!

The Park District has added several more "Dig Days" to the calendar to maintain and improve select trails and restore habitat. Registration opens one month before each event. Dig Days are scheduled for May 13, June 10, July 8, August 12, September 9, and October 14 from 9:00 a.m. to 2:00 p.m. [Register](#).
